Intervention Basics

(from Families Moving Forward, Heather Carmichael Olson, 2009)

- 1. Observe the individual's function and impact of **environment**.
- 2. Provide lots of **structure**, **routine** and **supervision**.
- 3. Use explicit instructions.

Environment

Observe the individual's level of functioning and how the environment in which they are immersed is impacting them.

- · What is school like for them?
- How is the home set up?
- · Is their world working to facilitate life for them or is it putting up barriers?

Structure/routine

Provide lots of structure, routine and supervision.

- This includes carefully structuring tasks at home, school, job, etc.
- Using a visual structure (picture schedules, tasks, creating an environment that is less stimulating and external ways to stay organized).

Instructions

Use explicit instructions.

- Don't rely on incidental or observational learning.
- Instead use consistent, experiential learning that involves real-world practice.
